A worst nightmare in clinical practice is a budgie coming down in respiratory distress. This lecture will use this case presentation to work our way comprehensively through the physical exam, pathophysiology, diagnosis, and potential treatments for small birds presenting in respiratory distress. An emphasis will be put on minimizing mortality during examination and diagnosis and focusing on bedside diagnostic options to allow owners and veterinary teams to make informed decisions, rather than empirical ones.

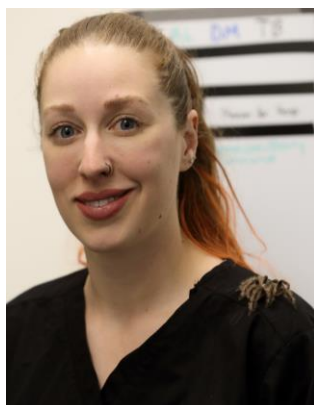

Gut Instincts - Diagnosing and Managing Rabbit GI Stasis *Dr. Teresa Bousquet, DABVP (Exotic Companion Mammal Practice), DVM* **November 4, 2025, at 7pm, Virtual** Approved for 1 hour of ABVMA CPD

Rabbits commonly present with abdominal pain but there are many potential causes. Using case examples, this lecture will explore the diagnosis and treatment of these patients. Case presentations will include Rabbit Gastrointestinal Stasis (RGIS), Liver Lobe Torsion (LLT), and Gastrointestinal Obstruction. An emphasis will be placed on managing these patients in a primary care setting and how to determine which patients may benefit from referral.
